Jones County and Eight Other Schools Districts Install Twenty-Five Polycom Dual Monitor Classroom Systems.

STONE MOUNTAIN, GEORGIA, March 2, 2006 - The Jones County School District in Southern Mississippi has installed dual monitor Polycom 8000 Distant Learning Classroom systems at four high schools in its own district and twenty-one in schools in eight adjacent school districts for a total of twenty-five new systems. The districts are leveraging a \$500,000 federal grant from the Department of Agriculture to promote business learning. "The combination of video conferencing capabilities with Accordent's Rich-Media Data Capture Appliance expands the usefulness of the newly equipped classrooms", says Scott Lewis, business manager for the Jones County District.

VisiCom Systems, Inc., a videoconferencing integrator based in Stone Mountain, Georgia was selected to install the twenty-five Polycom systems. VisiCom visited the twenty-five sites in November to perform preliminary sites visits. On Feb. 14th and 15th, three tractor trailer loads of equipment containing seventy pallets, each weighing approximately ninety pounds, arrived in Laurel to be loaded onto local delivery trucks. Three teams of VisiCom employees delivered the equipment to the sites, which were scattered over a 100-mile radius. Delivery was completed in three days and installation was completed by the close of business on Wednesday, February 22nd according to Leonard Salley, President of VisiCom Systems.

"I am extremely proud of the work that our team did in those seven days. They were committed – driven to excel. We needed to get the equipment installed so the project could move forward. They did the impossible – no one thought we could pull it off but my team proved them wrong", said Leonard Salley.
